Sunday – Noon – 8:00pm

Pool Rules:

- Seasonal pass holders must check in with the Lifeguard and sign in daily.
- **Guest privileges** are limited and not to be used in lieu of Membership. Members are responsible for their guests, including payment of guest fee **per person of \$10.00 upon arrival (card only)**. Members are allowed no more than 5 guests per day.
- Children 3 years old and under swim free.
- All non-swimming children in the water must be within reach of a parent or guardian.
- Inflatable water wings are not allowed.
- A coast guard approved personal floatation device is recommended.
- A guardian must be at least 16 years of age, and have written consent of a parent.
- No running. No diving in shallow end. Observe diving board regulations.
- No pets allowed in the pool area.
- No tobacco or vaping products allowed.
- No abusive or profane language.
- The pool is not responsible for personal property.
- All members must adhere to the pool rules.
- Members are liable for any property damage resulting from their actions and/or the actions of their children, grandchildren or guests.
- All members and guests, including children, use the pool and facilities at their own risk.
- Admission to the pool may be refused to anyone with a contagious condition.
- The lifeguard may clear the pool for designated swim periods, because of weather, or any other reason.
- The pool manager reserves the right to close the pool at any time due to any unexpected staffing, health or security issues. All efforts will be made to maintain normal operating hours.
- All babies must wear swim diapers with an elastic fitting.
- Clothing or swimsuits must be worn at all times.
- No jumping or diving off the lifeguard stand.
- Members should drive slowly and park carefully in the pool area and watch for children.
- No glass containers are allowed in the pool area.
- Food should be kept in the prescribed areas. No food products allowed in the pool.
- Members should clean up their own food, drink and trash.
- If a bathroom is not in proper order or needs supplies, please report this to a lifeguard.
- Lifeguards are not responsible for unattended children outside the pool area.

- **Swimming lessons** are available. Please speak with a lifeguard if you wish to set up a time for swimming lessons.
- **Reservations for pool parties/special events** outside of our regular business hours are available at a fee to cover a lifeguard, cleaning, etc.

Health, Safety, and Courtesy:

- The lifeguard on duty is in charge of the pool and pool facilities.
- The lifeguard's decisions and instructions must be followed at all times.
- All lifeguards are charged by the City of Lakesite to enforce rules related to health, safety and courtesy.
- Lifeguards have the authority to expel from the pool area any member or guest that fails to obey his/her instructions or fails to obey pool rules.
- If a child is asked to leave the pool due to misconduct, the parents will be notified.
- Children must be 14 years or older and capable of passing a swimming examination to visit the pool without a guardian.
- During peak hours, lifeguards may limit access for day and season pass holders for crowd safety control purposes.
