

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR STATED

MEETING OF THE

LAKESITE CITY COMMISSION

APRIL 19, 2005

Mayor Mullin called the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m. City Attorney McColpin gave the Invocation. Roll was called with Mayor Mullin, Vice Mayor Wilkerson, Commissioner Burkett, Commissioner McPherson, City Manager Edwards and City Attorney McColpin present. Commissioner Allis was absent. Commissioner McPherson made a motion to accept the March minutes. Vice Mayor Wilkerson seconded the motion. All Commissioners voted aye and motion carried.

Officer Ron Rice, Hamilton County Sheriff's Department, gave the Commissioners the March Sheriff's report. Commissioner Burkett asked about areas where there are traffic problems. Officer Rice said he would check to see if there are specific areas that have more accidents. There was no fire department report. Mayor Mullin said the Dallas Bay Volunteer Fire Department appreciated the donation for their thirty year birthday celebration.

City Manager Edwards said there would be a budget session on Tuesday, April 26, 2005 at 11:30 at Commissioner Burkett's office. He reported that state law requires training sessions for the City Judge and Court Reporter if we wish to keep the City Court.

Committee Reports: Parks & Recreation-Mayor Mullin reported that resurfacing the tennis and basketball courts will be done before July 1st. The skateboard park survey is being done as well as getting estimates for the pad. Public Works-Commissioner Burkett said a long range plan will be done for street work. Also plans to reinforce ordinances to define right of way issues. Budget & Finance-Commissioner McPherson said the budget is in good shape. Public Safety-Vice Mayor Wilkerson said the Sheriff's contract will be renewed June 30th and the only increase expected is for salary increases. He also asked for increased coverage on the park and City Hall areas and for watch lists on areas where vandalism has occurred.

To give applicants ample time to complete their applications for package liquor stores, Commissioner Burkett made a motion to extend the application deadline. Applications must be in to City Hall on June 15, 2005 at 12:00 noon. After discussion, the motion was amended to add that the Certificate of Compliance will be issued on July 20, 2005. Vice Mayor Wilkerson seconded the motion. All Commissioner voted aye and motion carried.

Commissioner Burkett moved to adjourn. Mayor Mullin adjourned the meeting at 7:45 p.m.
