

## **MINUTES OF THE REGULAR STATED**

### **MEETING OF THE**

### **LAKESITE CITY COMMISSION**

**AUGUST 16, 2005**

Mayor Mullin called the meeting to order at 7:07 p.m. City Attorney McColpin gave the Invocation. Roll was called with Mayor Mullin, Commissioner Allis, Commissioner Burkett, Commissioner McPherson, City Manager Edwards and City Attorney McColpin present. Vice Mayor Wilkerson was absent. Commissioner McPherson made a motion to accept the July minutes. Commissioner Burkett seconded the motion. All Commissioners voted aye and motion carried.

Officer Rice, Hamilton County Sheriff's Department, met with the Commissioners concerning traffic control, particularly in Chimney Hills, and also left booklets for a neighborhood watch program. He left the Sheriff's Department report for July. Mayor Mullin said the Dallas Bay Volunteer Fire Department reported that, effective December 1, 2005, the City of Lakesite will go from their present fire rating to a 5 fire rating.

Leroy Beasley, Chimney Hills Homeowners Association, was told Officer Rice would notify Sergeants to do additional patrols in Chimney Hills and will get feedback in about two weeks. Also more speed limit signs will be posted.

David Albury asked if the city will help with the road at Hensley Cemetery. Commissioner Burkett said he was looking into it.

Committee reports: Parks and Recreation; Commissioner Allis reported that the basketball court is awaiting final coating and striping. An exhaust fan in the pavilion will be checked into. He also will begin preparation work on a possible park site in the City. Budget and Finance; Commissioner McPherson explained that our new tax rate will be \$0.290 per \$100 valuation because of recent reevaluation of property. He reported that the Daisy Dallas sewer project is scheduled to be done by the end of September.

Mayor Mullin said Ordinance 157, Revenue Ordinance, setting the tax rate for the fiscal year, July 1, 2005-June 30, 2006, at \$0.290 per \$100 valuation of property passed on first

reading August 1, 2005 and on second and final reading on August 8, 2005. Attached, as though part of the minutes, is a copy of the commissioners vote on the Ordinance.

Commissioner Allis made a motion to pass Ordinance 156, amending Title 12, Chapters 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 and Title 7, Chapter 2, to adopt the 2003 edition of the sections of the International Code Council. Commissioner Burkett seconded the motion. Roll call vote: All Commissioners voted aye and Ordinance 156 passed on second and final reading.

Ordinances 158 and 159 will be tabled until the September meeting.

Commissioner Allis moved to adjourn. Mayor Mullin adjourned the meeting at 7:25 p.m.
