

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR STATED
MEETING OF THE
LAKESITE CITY COMMISSION
JANUARY 17, 2006**

Mayor Mullin called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m. Vice Mayor Wilkerson gave the Invocation. Roll was called with Mayor Mullin, Vice Mayor Wilkerson, Commissioner Burkett, Commissioner McPherson and City Manager Edwards present. Commissioner Allis was absent. City Attorney McColpin passed away since the last meeting and a replacement attorney will be found. Commissioner Burkett made a motion to approve the minutes of the November meeting. A meeting was not held in December. Commissioner McPherson seconded the motion. All Commissioners voted aye and motion carried.

Officer Laurey, Hamilton County Sheriff's Department, gave the December report. The November report had been left earlier. He reported that radar was set up in the City, but drivers see the patrol car and slow down. He said several alarm calls have been made the last few months. There was no Fire Department report.

Dick Ward commented about the loss of City Attorney McColpin and that he will be missed.

City Manager Edwards said that a committee has been formed, with eight people committed, to help find a way to attract businesses. There has been a meeting with TVA program officials to help guide the City. A luncheon meeting will be held Tuesday, February 21, 2006 at 11:00 a.m.. There will be three meetings held three weeks apart. City Manager Edwards brought to the attention of the commissioners communications from Representative Bo Watson concerning the Ethics Bill coming before the Tennessee General Assembly in Nashville. A copy of the Ethics Bill is available for review.

Committee reports: Commissioner Burkett said he has been in contact with Core Engineering concerning a five year preventative road maintenance plan. Commissioner McPherson reported that he sees no concerns with the budget at this time. Vice Mayor Wilkerson said the Sheriff's Department needs to not only check speeders but other violators such as drivers who do not stop at stop signs. He will check into what steps to take with junk cars.

Vice Mayor Wilkerson made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Burkett seconded the motion. Mayor Mullin adjourned the meeting at 7:25 p.m.
