



REQUIREMENTS FOR A DEMOLITION PERMIT

When is a Demolition Permit required?

A demolition permit is required when any building or structure or any building or structure's interior is to be demolished. Any renovation (regardless of size) requiring interior removal of materials may require a demolition permit.

What must be submitted to obtain a Demolition Permit?

- A completed Demolition Permit Application,
- A completed Land Disturbing Application for demolition (Required when footings/foundation is removed or when heavy equipment will be used to demo the structure) along with a site plan showing contours of property and location of silt-fencing.

What are the fees associated with the Demolition Permits?

A non-refundable fee for the Building Demolition permit is \$100.00

For all demolitions, all moves, and alteration of interiors requiring a demolition permit: This permit shall not be valid until final approval to proceed is received from the Air Pollution Control Bureau. To avoid costly non-compliance penalties, call (423) 643-5970 if you have any questions.

Permit shall become invalid if authorized work is not commenced within thirty (30) days after issuance of if work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six (6) months. This permit is issued with the distinct understanding that the building for which this permit is issued is to be built in strict accordance with all adopted codes of the City of Chattanooga, Tennessee. Persons performing construction work under this permit must observe all Federal, State and local codes.

For all demolitions, all moves, and alteration of residential with more than four dwelling units: This permit shall not be valid until final approval to proceed is received from the Air Pollution Control Bureau. To avoid costly non-compliance penalties, call (423) 643-5970 if you have any questions. **Per City Code:** Demolition shall not begin until sewer is properly capped at the property line and inspected by the City of Lakesite (if applicable) (initials of applicant) _____

Demolition, Renovation Projects, Asbestos Removals

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has determined that asbestos can cause cancer. In order to protect citizens from the health hazards presented by airborne asbestos fibers, **all building demolitions and many renovation projects require a permit from the Air Pollution Control Bureau.**

An application for an Asbestos Removal Permit, a Demolition Permit, or a Renovation Permit is to be completed and filed with the Bureau **a minimum of 10 working days before the start of any:**

Demolition Project: (with the exception one private residence containing less than five (5) dwelling units where the property has not been used for commercial, business or institutional purposes) regardless of whether the building contains asbestos or not. Demolition is any wrecking or removal of any load-supporting structural member of a facility. An Asbestos Survey* and a permit are required.

Renovation Project is the altering a facility or one or more facility components in any way, including stripping or removal of regulated asbestos-containing materials (RCAM) from a facility component. An Asbestos Survey* and a permit may be required.

Asbestos Removal Only Project is the removal of regulated asbestos-containing material or facility components that contain or are covered with regulated asbestos-containing material from any facility. A permit may be required.

**An Asbestos Survey includes an inspection, sample, and laboratory testing of suspected asbestos-containing materials. This must be conducted by an individual or company certified by the State of Tennessee.*

Demolition/Renovation Permit Application (attached) - this form may only be submitted through the following:


This application must be completed and filed with the Bureau a minimum of 10 working days before the start of any:

- **Renovation project** (altering a facility, or one or more facility components, in any way, including stripping or removal of regulated asbestos-containing materials from a facility component) where the amount of asbestos containing materials to be removed exceeds 260 linear feet of piping, 160 square feet of other facility components or 35 cubic feet.
- **Building demolition** (other than private residences containing less than five (5) dwelling units where the property has not been or will not be used for commercial, business or institutional purposes) regardless of whether the building contains asbestos or not. A demolition is any wrecking or removal of any load-supporting member of the structure.



To protect citizens from the health hazards presented by airborne asbestos fibers, all building demolitions and many renovation projects within Hamilton County require a permit from the Air Pollution Control Bureau.

Definitions

Demolitions - including renovations involving removal of any load-supporting structural member

- You must obtain a permit from the Chattanooga-Hamilton County Air Pollution Control Bureau (APCB) before demolishing part or all of any institutional, commercial or industrial building, apartment building with more than four units, or more than one residential structure within the same block or as part of a single project.
- You must provide written notice at least 10 days before demolition occurs, even if no asbestos is believed to be present. This notice must include a complete asbestos survey that has been performed by a qualified surveyor.
- The permit will be issued by the Director after the permit fee is paid.

Renovations – not involving removal or any load-supporting structural member

- You **must** have a permit to remove more than 260 linear feet or 160 square feet of friable asbestos-containing materials that will be disturbed during the renovation.

Friable Asbestos - Asbestos is friable if it can be crushed or crumbled by hand.
