**TERMINATION OF CIVIL EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION AND ORDERS
AND ADOPTION OF PHASED REOPENING ORDERS ISSUED PURSUANT TO
THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE**

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2020, the **City of Lakesite**, upon authorization of Tenn. Code Ann. 38-9-104(9), issued a **Civil Emergency Proclamation and Order effective as of 12:01 a.m. on March 26, 2020**, relating to the ongoing COVID-19 emergency; and

WHEREAS on March 22, 2020, the Governor of Tennessee issued Executive Order No. 17, **AN ORDER TO MITIGATE THE SPREAD OF COVID-19 BY LIMITING SOCIAL GATHERINGS, DINE-IN SERVICE, AND GYM USE, AND EXPOSURE AT NURSING AND RETIREMENT HOMES, AND PROVIDING FLEXIBILITY FOR RESTAURANTS REGARDING THE SALE OF ALCOHOL**; and

WHEREAS, the Governor has subsequently issued Executive Orders 21, 22, 23 and 27, expanding certain restrictions, but also providing for termination of the same on April 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on April 24, 2020, the Governor's Executive Order No. 29, made provision for the limited reopening of restaurants, subject to the authority of the Hamilton County Health Department to issue alternative orders; and

WHEREAS, Hamilton County has indicated it has adopted Executive Order No. 29 and will not issue alternative orders; and

WHEREAS, the Governor has stated that Tennesseans must maintain habits like social distancing, working from home when possible, handwashing, and utilizing cloth masks, and that certain restrictions will remain in place to ensure that citizens do this properly and safely, such as discouraging social gatherings of 10 or more and restricting visitors at nursing homes and hospitals until further notice; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager and the Mayor have determined that any requirement for emergency measures within the City related to the COVID-19 virus are met by the Governor's existing orders and anticipated future orders.

It is therefore **ORDERED**, as follows:

1. That the Civil Emergency Proclamation and Order dated March 20, 2020, effective as of 12:01 a.m. on March 26, 2020, is hereby rescinded on the basis that the Governor's Executive Orders of statewide effect have preempted the need for separate regulation of COVID-19 related measures by the City; and

2. That the City as property owner continues to retain exclusive jurisdiction over public parks, playgrounds, ballfields, trails and other areas owned exclusively by the City, and will make appropriate determinations as property owner as to public accessibility to the same.


